## **2020-2021 COMMUNITY & NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION**

Parents/Guardians:

Perkins Local Schools provides transportation to resident community and non-public school students in kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade who attend eligible non-public and community schools as required by Ohio Revised Code. Transportation is provided in accordance with the approved calendar of the community or non-public school of attendance.

Please note the following information regarding community/non-public school transportation for the upcoming school year:

- A transportation request must be submitted for each student every year (see below for instructions.)
- Enrollment and residency will be confirmed with the community/non-public school.
- Transportation is provided on the routine schedule.
  - Delayed starts are not able to be accommodated. If the community/non-public school schedules a delayed start, transportation is not provided.
  - Early releases may be accommodated. If the community/non-public school schedules an early release, transportation will be provided as long as it does not disrupt the routine schedule.
  - If Perkins Local Schools is closed due to inclement weather, there will be no transportation provided to community/non-public schools.
  - If Perkins Local Schools has a delayed start due to inclement weather and the community/non-public school does not, transportation is NOT provided.
  - If the community/non-public school has a delayed start due to inclement weather and Perkins Local Schools does not, transportation is NOT provided.
- Students enrolled in preschool/pre-kindergarten are not eligible for transportation.
- Students may be transported to and/or from a location other than the residence for child care purposes (if space is available on that route), but that location must be consistent Monday through Friday. Please see the request for full details regarding transportation to/from child care provider locations.

The following health and safety measures will be in place for school transportation:

- Drivers will wear face coverings unless exemption is met.
- No students will be seated in the seat directly behind the driver.
- Students will have assigned seats and are not permitted to switch seats during a route.
- Students must wear face coverings.
- Students will sit two per seat, up to three if from same household.
- Students from same household will be seated together whenever possible.
- Daily sanitizing will take place.
- Parents/guardians are encouraged to transport their child/children if possible.
- Parents/guardians must have students physically distanced at the bus stop.
