COMMUNITY AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose: To honor and support students who have demonstrated scholastic excellence, exemplary leadership, and community service. One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be awarded.

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Perkins Local Schools.
2. The applicant must have attended Perkins Local Schools continually for at least two years.
3. The applicant must have a cumulative weighted grade point average of 3.0 or above.
4. The applicant must have demonstrated leadership ability and exemplary citizenship through community involvement.
5. The applicant must be seeking higher education at a two- or four-year college or university.
6. The scholarship will be given once current proof of acceptance at a postsecondary institution is provided to the treasurer of Perkins Local Schools.
7. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution.
8. The applicant must submit the following:
  - A. The years they have attended Perkins Local Schools
  - B. Their most-recent transcript with cumulative weighted grade point average
  - C. Their future educational plans in as much detail as they know at the time (e.g., two- or four-year college, name of college)
  - D. A list of the leadership roles they have held and the years they held each
  - E. A list of their community service activities and the years they participated in each
  - F. A short essay (1-2 pages typed) that addresses the following:
    - Share ways you have served your community.
    - Identify one need or challenge you see in the community. Then, explain how you and/or others in the community might be able to address that need/challenge.
    - Describe what leadership means to you. Be specific with examples of your leadership.
