How To Qualify:

1. The student ***must be vision impaired*** [needing corrective lenses and/or having a disease affecting his/her vision]
2. The student ***must*** be college bound
3. The student ***must*** have school proof of at least a 2.5 GPA
4. The student ***must*** provide an Essay with His/Her application.

Application Guidelines:

1. The student ***must*** apply through the Guidance Office.
2. The student ***must*** submit the completed application to the Guidance Office prior to submission date.
3. The student is to write an essay:
 - a. The topic of the essay is, ***What Does Community Service and Serving the Community Mean to Me? And What I have done to Serve the Community?***
 - b. The essay is to be between 250-350 words in length
4. The scholarship winner is required to attend a Sandusky Lions Club meeting and read his/her essay to the membership
5. The scholarship check will then be issued, payable to the winning student after they submit a copy of a receipt from the college for payment; and a copy of their Acceptance Letter showing Student Identification Number (ID) with starting date of school.
6. Deadline for application acceptance is **April 3, 2020**. **There will not be any exceptions to submission date.**
