QUALIFICATIONS

Applicant should be a current senior at Perkins High School or a current Perkins High School senior at EHOVE.

Applicant must be enrolled in a 2-year, 3-year or 4-year technical school, college or university.

Applicant should submit a Charles J. Waldock Memorial Scholarship application to the Perkins High School Guidance Office by March 30th.

Applicants who express an intention to pursue post high school studies in an Agricultural related career field will be given priority.

The Waldock Scholarship Committee will give priority to 4-H members or applicants with a farming background.

Recipient may receive only one Charles J. Waldock Scholarship.

The Waldock Scholarship Committee shall establish the amount of the scholarship and select the scholarship recipient in cooperation with the Perkins High School principal and/or the guidance department.

The Treasurer of the Perkins Local Schools will make the check payable to the recipient upon proof of enrollment and evidence of a tuition payment to the school, college or university that the recipient will attend.
